This year's speaker is Warwick Turner, one of the founders of the Sydney Heritage Fleet who was instrumental in saving and restoring *Lady Hopetoun* back in the 1960s, an experience that set him on a path that maintained a deep involvement with museums that exists to this day.

Warwick has had a life-long passion and interest in steam vessels and their restoration, in particular the inland paddle-steamers of previous centuries. He will speak about his fascinating background, some of the classic steam vessels that have caught his eye over the years, and the way forward in understanding and preserving our maritime heritage.
