



Sailing Information and Terms & Conditions

Northern Voyage 2015

James Craig is taking 12 fare paying passengers on the northern voyage. Passengers will have the opportunity of either joining in with the crew watches, or just sitting back and relaxing aboard this fantastic 19th Century Square-Rigged ship.

1. *James Craig* will normally sail in all weather and tickets will not be refunded due to rain.
2. The cost for this voyage will be \$1,600 and must be paid in full prior to boarding.
3. Passengers are accommodated in bunks or hammocks.
4. If, in the opinion of the Master on the day of the sail, the wind or sea state is deemed unsuitable for the safety and/or comfort of passengers, the event will be delayed until wind or sea state is deemed suitable. If the voyage is to be cancelled, passengers will receive a full refund.
5. The ship's voyages will operate under sail where possible, or a combination of sail and motor if required.
6. For departure from Sydney please be at Wharf 7, 58 Pirrama Road, Pymont, on **Saturday 14th of February 2015 for boarding at 0900** (crew call is 0800), ready for a 1000 departure. The ship will not wait for latecomers. Departure times are subject to change. The ship will return to Wharf 7, 58 Pirrama Road, Pymont at around 1000 on Thursday the 19th of February 2015.
7. Any cancellations by the passenger will incur a 10% administration fee. Tickets are transferrable to another person at no extra cost.
8. Minimum age for children is 16 years.
9. All meals are included in the ticket price.
10. Please dress for all weather and be aware that weather can change. Sharp heeled shoes are not permitted onboard.
11. Passengers have the choice to help the crew or just relax.
12. *James Craig* is a restored 19th Century sailing ship, and there are no luxuries. Conditions will not always be pleasant if the weather is unkind. The need to conserve water may require days at sea without showers.
13. Passengers will use steep stairs to board the ship and to go down into the ship's lower decks. We regret that wheelchair access is not available due to *James Craig* being a restored 19th century ship.
14. Smoking is only allowed in a designated area on the main deck of the ship.
15. Sydney Heritage Fleet accepts no responsibility for lost or damaged property.
